Privacy Statement for Recruitment

Reasons for Processing: Hertfordshire Good Care is a trading name of Hertfordshire Care Providers Association ltd. (HCPA). By submitting any sort of application material, either written or recorded, to HCPA you the applicant are entering into an agreement limited exclusively to the recruitment process. HCPA reserve the right to contact you again within that six-year retention period should newly advertised roles match your skillset.

Scope: Only data relevant to your application will be sought by HCPA. Should you submit unsolicited additional information not relevant to your application that cannot be easily separated from that needed then it will be stored and retained on the same principals as above.

Security: HCPA hold themselves to the standards set by the Information Commissioners Office in assuring that any personal data handled by them is as secure as they can reasonably make it. HCPA maintain the Cyber Essentials accreditation.
