

How to host a photography competition



What you'll need -

- Consent from those in any photographs
- Risk assess images being uploaded to a wider audience than those at home, like social media.
- Camera, mobile phone or other devise to take pictures
- A computer to upload and a printer to display the images
- Rules, can the photographs be taken indoors and outdoors?
- Can they be in colour and black and white?
- Are filters accepted?
- Who will judge the entries?
- Will there be a prize for the winner?

Method -

Photos can be taken on behalf of an entrant, by a staff member for example, under strict instruction and guidance of entrant and also these instructions must be evidenced on winning. Example - "A photo from the lounge, of the sunset through the trees please." Encourage a wide range of entries, from capturing heartfelt moments to stunning scenery and wildlife.
