What you'll need -

- Spring
- A camera
- A garden or fields to walk through
- Internet to research

Method -

Staff can take a walk around the garden and take photos of the spring plants you see appearing all over.

Engage with your audience, asking what each one is and encourage meaningful discussion.

For example, daffodils are associated with the famous poet William Wordsworth. Many people can remember the start of the poem “**I wandered lonely as a cloud**”.

You'll be surprised at how many people who can recite this entire poem, word for word.
